## Dolci gets Romantic

The term "Romance" means a short concert piece in one movement with the emotional immediacy of a song, conveying tenderness or a reflective mood. A number of wonderful works share this title, partly because most composers from Mozart to Rachmaninoff considered themselves Romantics.
